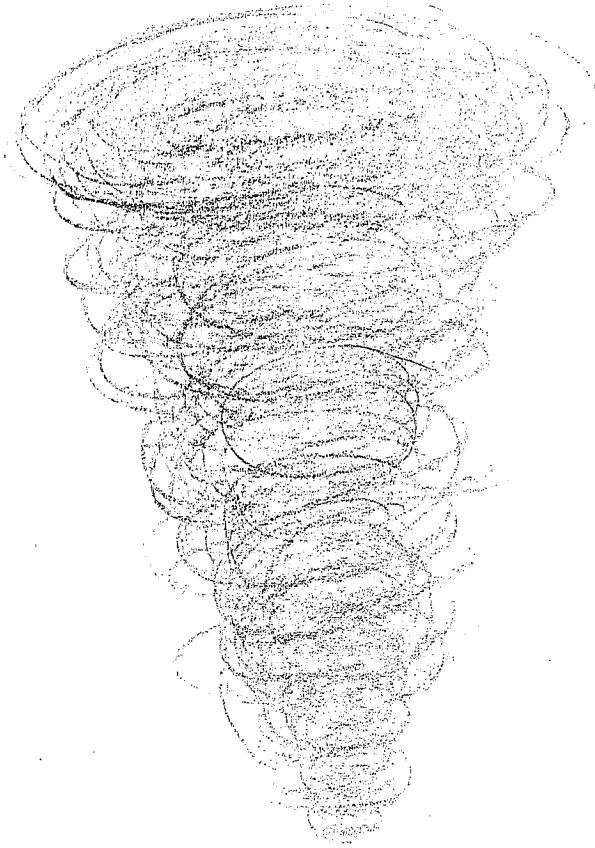


# TYBALT



Tybalt is furious with Romeo for attending the Capulet party. Tybalt's rage shines through with the fury of a tornado, "It fits when such a villain is a guest. I'll not endure him," (I.v.73-74). His inability to calm the anger forces Lord Capulet to have him leave the party. The anger that Tybalt exemplifies in the first act shows he is like a tornado. The destruction that results from a tornado is much like the fury of Tybalt.

**Forecast:** Since Tybalt's tornado is anger, it is likely his fury will explode and result in bloodshed later in the play. Death by Tybalt is likely.
